POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

TAKING OF IMPRESSIONS FOR IMPLANT RETAINED OVER-DENTURES

Dental prosthetists with appropriate training may be involved in the planning and construction of implant retained over-dentures in co-operation with a dentist and may deal directly with the public to take impressions and construct such dentures, once healing of implant/abutment sites is complete.

He/she may not:

- o deal directly with the public concerning implant supported prostheses unless the prosthetist has completed the Competency Unit HLTDP608A ~ “Construct and Insert an Implant Retained Overdenture” from the Health Training Package ~ HLT07 ~ Advanced Diploma of Dental Prosthetics, or an equivalent course containing competency based assessment; or
- o deal directly with the public while implant/abutment sites are healing; or
- o place, remove or replace implant or abutment components; or
- o deal directly with the public for any aspect of any other dental implant retained prosthesis; or
- o deal directly with the public where precision attachments, attached to a natural tooth/tooth root, form part of the prosthetic structure or where the prosthesis is part of an obturator.
